Medical Mission teams plan to continue their visits to impoverished villages in Moldova and Ukraine, bringing much needed help and relief to those who otherwise would have little access to medical care. Pray that as the Gospel is preached at each clinic sin sick souls will find spiritual healing and relief from their sin burdens.

Focus on Ukraine

Monday 24

Several of the new missionaries supported through SGA's Project70 are planting churches in the war zone area of E. Ukraine. Already 24 new churches have been established in the "grey zone" region. Pray that God will use their efforts as a means of adding more to His Kingdom.

Tuesday 25

Hot meals and medicine are often provided by churches in Ukraine, as a means of evangelizing the lost and helping those in need. Pray that these opportunities will be blessed by God and that many will be brought to faith in Christ.

Wednesday 26

Pray for Peter & Valentina Osmochescu, serving the Lord among the Roma communities of Remet, Ukraine. One of their endeavours is to teach children to read and write as well as teaching them from the Bible. Pray that they will be able to reach young hearts with the Word of the Lord.

Thursday 27

One of SGA's Project70 missionaries, Yuriy Leshenko, working in the Donetsk region of Ukraine writes, "Please pray that we would find a bigger hall for worship as the place we gather in now is small already for our church and in the summer, it will simply be impossible to conduct worship services there." Praise God for a wonderful problem! May He provide the facilities required.

Friday 28

Reconstruction work continues on a new House of Prayer in Vendichani, Ukraine. It is hoped that this will be ready for use in the Autumn. Pray that many will be able to worship the true and living God in this place.

Saturday 29 & Sunday 30

A church building or "House of Prayer" is essential in Orthodox countries for believers to be considered credible. Pray for the effective witness of each House of Prayer, and that many more will be constructed in future days, particularly in remote villages. Pray for pastors and evangelists who often have the responsibility of caring for several small fellowships.

Monday 31

Pray for the distribution of Kazakh Bibles and children's Bibles among Muslim families, and that many will find the God of the Bible and be converted.
