Saturday 1 & Sunday 2

Monday 17

Tuesday 18

Praise God for the 5th intake of students in Ruptawa Mission School, POLAND. Pray for the directors, Pastors Tomasz Chylka and Andrzej Karzalek, who offer support and guidance to the students.
