Monday 1

Preparation is underway for SGA-sponsored camps in **MOLDOVA, UKRAINE, CENTRAL ASIA, MONGOLIA** and **ARMENIA**. Pray that the leaders will be well prepared to carry out their responsibilities.

Tuesday 2

Pray that all the logistics of running the camp ministry will come together very smoothly. Pray that the Day Camp teams in **MOLDOVA** and **UKRAINE** will be led to villages with open hearts for the Gospel.

Wednesday 3

SGA-sponsored missionary, David P., has been appointed to oversee youth ministry in **KAZAKHSTAN** for the next 3 years. Pray that he will be enabled by God to fulfil this role.

Thursday 4

Alexander V., a missionary in **TAJIKISTAN**, requests prayer for wisdom with ministry to children and youth - that among them new servants of God would be raised to serve their people.

Friday 5

Pray for Field Director Mark Foster as he presents reports of SGA's ministries in NW England and facilitates the teaching schedules across Europe and Asia. May he and his wife, Margaret, know the Lord's blessing.

Saturday 6 & Sunday 7

SGA supports Resources for Ministry, previously known as Independent Bible Correspondence School in **CENTRAL ASIA**. With 550 students enrolled for the courses, and churches now using the material for training church-based groups, these courses can have both far-reaching and God-glorifying Gospel impact. Pray to that end.

Monday 8

Pray for Dmitry in **KAZAKHSTAN** as he develops youth ministry by opening a teens club and starting new home groups. Pray that the Lord will provide new preachers and servants for the church.

Tuesday 9

SGA's Administrative Assistant, Annina Lee, is coordinating the mission trips to Hungary and Romania. Pray for her alongside her husband Joshua.

Wednesday 10

We praise God that in February 43 new students commenced their studies in the Preachers' School, **MONGOLIA**. Pray that they will be well-equipped to preach God's Word.



Thursday 11

Pray for SGA's Regional Representative in the North of England and North Wales, Billy McCurrie, as he shares at many events. Remember him alongside his wife, Roberta.

Friday 12

With the growing number of students at Almaty Bible Institute, **KAZAKHSTAN**, a pressing need developed for new staff members. Pray for new staff members Alexander and Anastasia, who have joined the team.

Saturday 13 & Sunday 14

Regional Coordinator, Pastor Peter Mihalchiuk (**MOLDOVA**), continues his vital ministry as director of the Balti Mission School, where a full quota of students is studying. Tuesday 16
