Monday 6

Tuesday 7

Students graduate this week from the Targoviste Mission School, **ROMANIA**. Pray for Mark Foster as he teaches and participates in the special graduation event.

Wednesday 8

Eric MacDonald, Scottish Representative, with his wife Kay, would appreciate your prayers as they visit churches across Scotland. Pray for new opportunities to share about God's work.

Thursday 9

Pray for the SGA-supported medical teams which, under the leadership of Sergey Shalinsky, **UKRAINE**, are visiting communities devastated by war.

Friday 10

Pray for Mukhamat (**UZBEKISTAN**), (who is completely deaf) as he pastors a house church and is responsible for the churches in his region, travelling 50-60 miles weekly.

Saturday 11 & Sunday 12

In July, camps will be convened across **MONGOLIA** and **CENTRAL ASIA**. Pray for the leaders who will be responsible for teaching God's Word. This is a great Gospel opportunity as many campers will be from non-Christian backgrounds, including Buddhist, Muslim, Orthodox and others. Pray for conversions to Christ.

Monday 13

Pray for SGA General Director, Derek Maxwell and his wife Carole. May Derek know wisdom and courage in making decisions, and renewed daily strength for all his tasks.

Tuesday 14

Billy McCurrie would value prayer as he commences a short itinerary in the Isle of Man. Pray that he will be an encouragement as he shares about the work and ministers God's Word.

Wednesday 22

Pray for Pastor Igor Bandura and the many pastors in **UKRAINE** who, despite being exhausted in this prolonged war, continue in ministry. Pray that their strength will be renewed and God's wisdom provided in decision-making.

Thursday 23

Pavel (**UZBEKISTAN**), along with his congregation, purchased a plot of land for the construction of a new House of Prayer. Pray that the necessary documents will be issued.

Friday 24

Pray for Assistant to the Field Director, David Anderson, with his wife Janette as they lead the mission team to Orgovany, **HUNGARY**. Pray that all the travel and logistics will go smoothly.

Saturday 25 & Sunday 26

Pray for the Western Siberian Bible College, Omsk, **RUSSIA**, under the leadership of Ivan Makarov, which currently has over 100 students in training for missionary work in Siberia, Far East Russia, Mongolia and North Kazakhstan.
