Friday 28

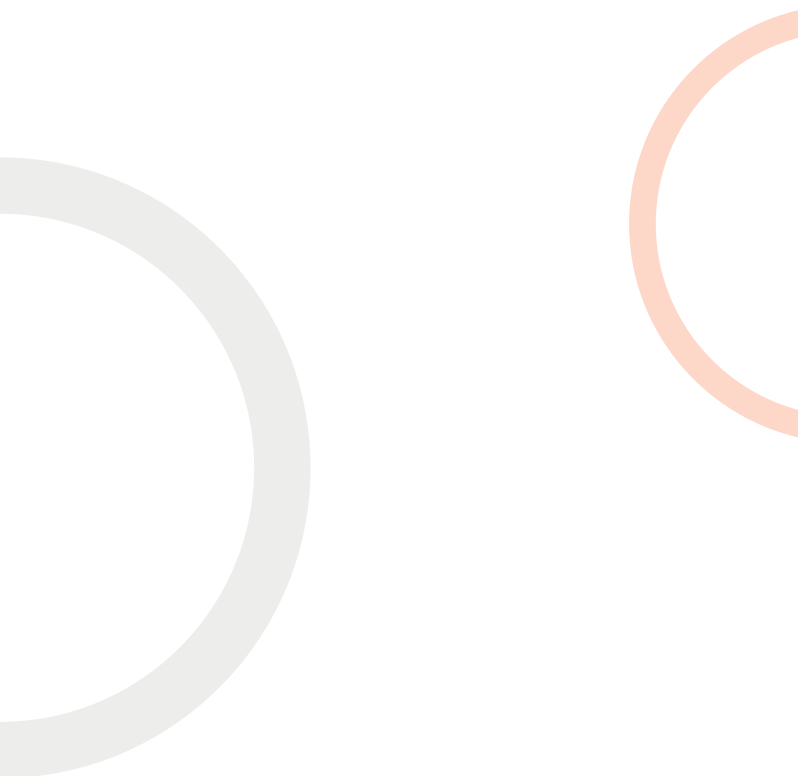
